PUBLIC NOTICE OF STORM WATER DISCHARGE

The Iowa Department of Transportation plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit No. 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities."

The storm water discharge will be from construction activity located in Butler County on IA Highway 57. The project is bridge replacement with RCB culvert at Gran Creek 0.5 mi. E. of Co. Rd. T19.

The Public Lands Survey location

is Township 90N, Range 18W, Sections 24/25.

Storm water will be discharged from 4 point sources and will be discharged into the following streams: road ditches to Gran Creek.

The Aplington City Council met in regular session on December 14, 2022. Jason Mehmen, Mayor, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Council members present: Schipper, Meyer, Uhlenhopp, and Jacobs. Council member Lage was absent.

A motion by Schipper, seconded by Jacobs, to approve the consent agenda, which includes the agenda, the financial report ending November 2022, and a list of claims as presented, carried unanimously.

Jeff Ridder, Public Works Department, reported on daily routines. Bids were open for the trencher with the high bid of \$250, submitted by Matthew Klahsen. The high bid for the generator was submitted by John's Auto for \$1277.00.

Chief Lind reported on the excellent progress of our new officer, Jessica Hinz. She will be attending the police academy in March.

Scott Poppen, Aplington Fire Chief, gave a short report on the calls and training.

Holli Harken presented the Council with a contract from One Design & Engineering for design on the pool project. The contract will be sent to Dave Kuehner, City Attorney, for review.

A motion by Meyer, seconded by Schipper to approve the revision on Resolution 518-22-1, approving the change in hours and rate for the police department and the Utility clerk, carried unanimously.

A motion by Jacobs, seconded by Uhlenhopp, to approve the Urban renewal (TIF) report, carried unanimously.

The Clerk will be starting the budget for FY24 after valuations are received by the county Auditor.

In processing the November 2022 code supplements by Iowa Codification, there were a few items of

concern and conflict that needs the City's attention. The clerk will make the needed changes and all will be placed on the January agenda for review and approval.

The City Shelter house is in need of repairs. The Council will look at possibly windows and siding.

Falcon Signs were constructed by the AP industrial arts students for the downtown planters. The @homeAplington group will be placing them during the spring. A motion by Meyer, seconded by Uhlenhopp, to approve paying half of the signs with @homeAplington paying half, carried unanimously.

In other business, Uhlenhopp mentioned the maintenance building at the Pleasant View Cemetery. The results of the survey for the cemetery will be discussed after it is received from Clapsaddle & Garber.

There being no further business, a motion by Meyer, seconded by Schipper, to adjourn, carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:04 p.m.

He encourages Butler County to do research on certain requirements and take a stronger stance against the pipeline. He thanked the board for their work on Shell Rock Soy Processing.

Board considered an Ahlers Cooney Engagement Letter for Representation in the Matter of Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Permits and Regulations with Timothy Whipple from Ahlers Cooney. Mr. Whipple was online and available to answer questions. Barnett asked how many counties have been in communication with him and Whipple listed the different ways that other counties have been working with them. He also explained that certain counties have been sued by the CO2 pipeline, and their firm is representing those counties in Federal Court.
