Notice is hereby given to the public that the Parkersburg City Council will meet for its regularly scheduled meeting and hold a public hearing on June 5, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. at the Parkersburg Civic Center to consider amending section 106.08(1)(A) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Parkersburg, Iowa, describing the schedule of fees for solid waste collection and disposal service for each residential premise and each dwelling unit of a multiple-family dwelling with all parts not specifically amended or repealed remaining in effect: 106.08(1)(A) COLLECTION FEE. For each residential premise and each dwelling unit of a multiple-

family dwelling – the fee shall be \$21.00 per month for the collection of one 65 gallon garbage can per week. Any additional solid waste set out for collection must be placed in City approved bags available from designated vendors at a cost of \$2.00 per bag. Any bags or cans exceeding the gallon or weight limit per premises will not be picked up by the collector.
