Parkersburg, Iowa The City Council of the City of Parkersburg, Iowa met in regular session on Monday, Augutst 5, 2024 at 7:00 P.M. at the Parkersburg Civic Center. Council members present: Bellows, Cuvelier, Manifold, Schneiderman, and Simon.

Mayor Mike Timmer called the meeting to order and led those in attendance in reciting the Pledge of

There was a motion by Cuvelier, seconded by Schneiderman to approve the minutes. Upon vote, all

ayes.

Councilman Simon joined the meeting in progress.

There was a motion by Schneiderman, seconded by Simon to approve the bills. Upon vote, all ayes. On behalf of the Public Works Department, Tim Kolder presented a bid to complete the necessary asphalt street repairs that need to be done. The bid included asphalt patching Northside Road to the Wolf's Landing area as well. There was a motion by Manifold, seconded by Simon to approve the bid with Kluesner Construction. Upon vote, all ayes.

Tim presented quotes from Cole Excavation to repair storm sewer intakes on Watson Way and to repair intakes at the intersection of Miners Street and Wemple Street as well. There was a motion by Schneiderman, seconded by Cuvelier to accept the bids for an amount not to exceed \$27,000.00 to complete the

repairs. Upon vote, all ayes. There was a motion by Cuvelier,

seconded by Manifold to approve of the street closure on Nicklaus Drive for residents to have a block party on September 14, 2024 from approximately 4:00 pm - 10:00 pm. Upon vote, all ayes.

There was discussion about the infrastructure projects completed in the past several years and the projects that remain to be completed. Cost estimates were provided and the availability of grant funds to help pay for some of the projects was discussed. Reconstructing Johnson Street was discussed and City Engineer Lee Gallentine provided a cost estimate of 1.8 million to reconstruct the roadway from Wemple Street to Highway 57/14.

Rus Boersma provided an update of the Fire Department, including that he has been visiting local businesses / residents to get financial support to replace the department's airpacks.

Julie Folken stated the library copier will be getting replaced this week. She also informed the City Council that 1305 people attended the summer programs offered this summer by the library. Julie thanked the numerous contributors and volunteers for the success of the summer programming.

Engineer Lee Gallentine provided an up-to-date engineering services agreement for the design and construction of the Parkersburg Trail Project Phase 2 through Schwartz Park to Florence Street. There was a motion by Cuvelier, seconded by Schneiderman to approve the agreement. Upon vote, all ayes.

private contractors.
