ing aspect.
County Assessor, Dave Wangsness, explained an error in a few military credit disallowances. Tom Heckman, Butler County Veterans Affairs Director, was also present to explain his misinterpretation of the information provided. Wangsness will contact those affected to explain

the corrective action being taken.
Butler County EMS Director, Kari
Coates, explained the updates to

the existing 28E agreement with Butler County EMS which was last updated in 2014. Motioned by Dralle to approve the updated 28E Agreement, second by Barnett. All ayes.
